LONGHOUSE OVERNIGHT*

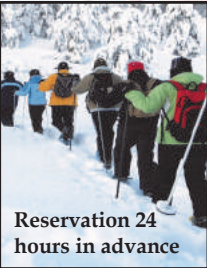
Go back to 1534, during the pre-contact era, live an extraordinary adventure and spend a night in the traditional longhouse. Your “pre-contact” experiences included :

ON THE WOLF TRAIL*

Since Aataentsic fell on the carapace of the great Turtle (Earth), our Wendat men go hunting. This hunting season extends from October to the end of December. As the snow is already falling at this time of year, our men had to bring and use their snowshoes to make it easier to move around.

They will hunt all sorts of animals. They hunt small beasts such as muskrats and hares; They pull beavers and porcupines such as mooses and bears. We propose you to relive this adventure with a First Nation guide :

- Snowshoeing in the woods;
- Target arc hunting simulation;
- Discussions on hunting techniques;
- Traditional bannock cooking on outdoor fire.

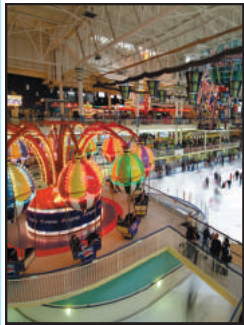
